

What do You See?

2 Corinthians 12:1-10

Background: Paul's authority and legitimacy are being questioned. He spends some time defending himself, although he tells us that nothing will be gained. He tells us about a man who went to heaven and received revelations about the Lord. Most likely, Paul is talking in third person about himself.

He points out that boasting about what God is doing matters but not boasting on ourselves.

I. Godly Vision is best seen when we see ourselves less than others. V7a

II. Godly Vision is best seen through teary eyes. V7b

III. Godly vision has many prisms. V7-8c

IV. Godly vision requires God's Grace, God's Power, and our weakness. V9
